



DIDs is Done!

AltaLIS is pleased to announce that the Disposition Mapping Project, which included the compilation of 232,000 active dispositions, 59,000 new dispositions and 24,000 amendments into a seamless provincial mapping base, was completed as scheduled on October 1, 2009.

The Digital Integrated Dispositions (DIDs) mapping product was created through a partnership between the Alberta Government's (GOA's) Public Lands Division and Spatial Data Warehouse (SDW) and is now available through their distribution agency, AltaLIS Ltd.

The project began 4 years ago to integrate existing dispositions (i.e. licenses, leases and permits), and maintain the data by adding new activities as they were approved. The goal: to create an integrated framework that would support an automated approval process and effective long term management of activities on Public (Crown) land.

DIDs mapping is available in 250K blocks or a seamless provincial coverage in GIS and CAD formats, by transaction or subscription, through the AltaLIS Virtual Order Desk.

The access subscription price is \$2000 per year, which includes unlimited downloads from our Virtual Order Desk. Municipalities or other 'defined' service areas are available for \$200 per year. Transactional access fees are \$100 for the first 250K file plus \$25 for each additional file, to a maximum of \$500 (within the same transaction).

What's next? ... Dispositions in the Special Areas are not managed by Public Lands and were not included in the original DIDs initiative. SDW, Public Lands and Special Areas have since come to an agreement to include some disposition types (MSL/LOC) in the DIDs data set. This additional data should be integrated by early 2010.
