



New ATS V4.1 Polygons

AltaLIS is pleased to announce a new ATS Polygon product is now available.

Due to industry feedback and GOA requirements, AltaLIS was requested to build a new set of ATS V4.1 Polygons which became available to industry in August 2009.

The primary changes from the previous version are:

- Road Allowance (RA) polygons were created for all layers except Townships.
- RA polygons were incorporated directly into each of the layers.
- RA polygons were created to the smallest possible rectangles.
- Some attribute names and values have changed.

There are now two sets of ATS polygons. One includes the full sections, quarters and LSDs even if they are partially in BC. The other set is clipped to the Alberta boundary. These polygons remain consistent with the Alberta ATS V4.1 coordinate file.

The data is available in 50 - 250K blocks or seamless provincial coverages.

Pricing for the new polygons remains the same: \$1,000 for provincial coverage down to the LSD level or \$750 down to the quarter sections. The new road allowance polygons are included.

Those who have acquired ATS polygons or linework from AltaLIS in the past may have their data replaced with this newer version for a \$100 processing fee.
