The Base Feature Project merged, connected, updated, restructured, revised, and attributed several topographic themes covering Alberta, using various resources such as provincial 20K, 50K, crown Alberta Vegetation Inventory (AVI), and Indian Remote Sensing (IRS) satellite imagery.

There are update initiatives ongoing by the Provincial Government, and a plan has been put in place for more updating programs to be funded through SDW / AltaLIS.
