



AltaLIS Provides DID's FTP Update Service

AltaLIS is pleased to announce a new FTP delivery service for DID's users. This allows organizations to automate the daily (nightly) update processing for DID's data.

For a modest fee, users are assigned a dedicated FTP site from which they can pull updates from AltaLIS servers using their own automatic update routines and eliminate manual processes.



DID's mapping provides government and industry with an accurate, complete, and timely spatial inventory of activities on Public (Crown) Land. The DID's mapping dataset was originally built, and is now maintained, without using any taxpayer dollars. It is funded through the SDW/GOA Public Private Partnership (P3).

Since the 2009 project completion, the product continues to be maintained by integrating new applications and amendments as they are approved. AltaLIS began providing daily updates in 2011.
