Digital Integration Dispositions (DIDs)

The Lands Division of Sustainable Resource Development has initiated the DIDs project that will integrate over 230,000 existing surface activity extents over the next 4 years, and maintain the data by adding new activities as they are approved.

The product itself will be free, and by the 4th quarter of 2006 DIDs access subscriptions will allow users to preview and download the data as areas are completed. Access fees will be \$0 in 2006, \$1000 in 2007, \$1500 in 2008, and \$2000 every year after.
