

Topo Stakeholder Forums Scheduled

As a result of a recently negotiated agreement between the Government of Alberta and SDW/AltaLIS, funds from the sale of topographic mapping products will be made available for update and development of provincial topographic data. To ensure that the Alberta topographic data meets the needs of users, Alberta Sustainable Resource Development (ASRD) and Spatial Data Warehouse (SDW), will be gathering perspectives and feedback from key stakeholders on the current and future requirements for provincial topographic data. This input will be used to help define requirements, and in setting priorities, on coverage, currency, content and accuracy of provincial topographic data.

ASRD and SDW will be hosting two stakeholder forums to discuss future requirements for provincial topographic mapping data. The forums will be held in both Edmonton and Calgary from 9:00am to approximately 3:30pm. Lunch will be provided. The dates and venues for the sessions are as follows:
